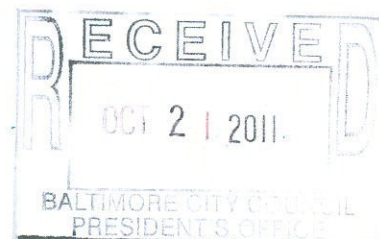
RE: Bill No. 11-0773 Ashburton Historic District
