15 16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$454,415 in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for
17	Fiscal Year 2025.
18	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
19	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.
20	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
21	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated or is for a new program that could
22	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
23	On October 15, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
24	Council.

## Council Bill 25-0108

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$454,415 shall be made available to Liquor License Board – Service 851 (Liquor License
Compliance) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2025, to
provide funding to balance the Liquor License Board's Fiscal Year 2025 budget for a deficit
caused by office lease costs, use of privately leased vehicles, and overtime. The source of
revenue for this appropriation is General Fund assigned Fund Balance in excess of the amount
from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required
to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
