1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **General Fund Operating Appropriation Transfer –**  
3 **Department of Public Works (Program 515 - Solid Waste Collection) to**  
4 **the Baltimore City Police Department (Program 201 - Field Operations Bureau) –**  
5 **\$3,546,000**

6 FOR the purpose of transferring a General Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of  
7 \$3,546,000 from the Department of Public Works - Program 515 (Solid Waste Collection) to  
8 the Baltimore City Police Department - Program 201 (Field Operations Bureau) to provide  
9 funding to pay for additional operating expenses in Fiscal 2009; and providing for a special  
10 effective date.

16 **Recitals**

17 Article VI, § 9(a)(2) of the City Charter provides that, on recommendation of the Board of  
18 Estimates, the City Council by ordinance may authorize the transfer of an appropriation  
19 contained in the Ordinance of Estimates from one municipal agency to another municipal  
20 agency.

21 The sum to be transferred from the agency program designated in this ordinance is not  
22 needed for which it was appropriated and, therefore, is available for transfer to another agency.

23 On May 27, 2009, the Board of Estimates recommended the transfer authorized by this  
24 Ordinance.

25 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
26 sum of \$3,546,000 contained in the Fiscal 2009 Ordinance of Estimates as a General Fund
