

City Council Bill 16-0649 has been introduced for the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to grant 3 perpetual easements to the Maryland State Highway Administration for the maintenance of 3 storm water drainage inlets along Dulaney Valley Road, through the property of the Loch Raven Reservoir, in Baltimore County, Maryland, as shown on Plats 60060 and 60061 filed in the State Highway Administration State Roads Commission; and providing for a special effective date.

The City would not have utility or other interests affected by the granting of these easements, and grantees would be responsible for the cost to maintain the easements. The City would retain access to the area when necessary but would be held harmless from all legal actions, losses, and damages. Additionally, any structures erected over the easement would require advance approval by the City.

The Department of Finance has no objection to the passage of Council Bill 16-0649.
