

**AMENDMENTS TO COUNCIL BILL 26-0201
(1st Reader Copy)**

Amendment No. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after “fund;” insert “generally relating to the parking benefits district fund;”.

Amendment No. 2

On page 1, in line 18, strike “EXCLUSIVELY”; and, on that same page, in lines 20 and 21, strike “THE AREA THAT IMMEDIATELY SURROUNDS THE POINT OF REVENUE COLLECTION.” and substitute “DESIGNATED PARKING BENEFITS DISTRICTS.”.

Amendment No. 3

On page 2, in line 2, strike “OF BALTIMORE”; and, on that same page, in that same line, after “ESTABLISH” insert “1 OR MORE”; and, on that same page, in line 5, strike “CERTAIN” and substitute “DEFINED”; and, on that same page, in lines 5 and 6, strike “WHERE PARKING REVENUES MAY BE COLLECTED.” and substitute “IN PROXIMITY TO THE SOURCE OF PARKING REVENUE COLLECTION.”.

Amendment No. 4

On page 2, in line 8, strike “OF BALTIMORE MAY,” and substitute “SHALL.”; and, on that same page, in line 9, strike “FUND.” and substitute “FUND, INCLUDING:

(1) DISTRIBUTION OF MONEY WITHIN THE FUND; AND

(2) AGENCY RESPONSIBILITY FOR FUND ADMINISTRATION.”.

Amendment No. 5

On page 2, after line 9, insert:

“(D) *ADVISORY COMMISSION.*

(1) *IN GENERAL.*

THERE IS A COMMISSION TO PROVIDE ADVICE AND RECOMMENDATION TO THE AGENCY ADMINISTERING THE FUND, THE MEMBERS OF WHICH SHALL BE APPOINTED, CONFIRMED, AND SHALL SERVE PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IV, § 6 {“APPOINTMENTS OF MUNICIPAL OFFICERS”} OF THIS CHARTER.

(2) *COMPOSITION AND GOVERNANCE.*

THE COMPOSITION AND GOVERNANCE OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE.

(3) *DUTIES.*

THE COMMISSION SHALL:

(I) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO, ADVISE, AND CONSULT WITH THE AGENCY ADMINISTERING THE FUND REGARDING:

(A) THE ESTABLISHMENT OF POLICIES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE IMPLEMENTATION, EXPENDITURES, AND ONGOING OPERATION OF THE FUND; AND

(B) THE DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS AND GRANTS TO ENSURE EQUITABLE ACCESS TO DIVERSE COMMUNITIES ACROSS THE CITY;

(II) ENSURE AN AUDIT OF THE FUND IS CONDUCTED EVERY 4 YEARS BY A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTING FIRM; AND

(III) EXERCISE ANY ADDITIONAL DUTY RELATED TO THE FUND, AS DIRECTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL.”;

and, on that same page, in line 10, strike “(D)” and substitute “(E)”.

Amendment No. 6

On page 2, in line 13, strike “FOR:” and substitute “FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES WITHIN A PARKING BENEFITS DISTRICT:”; and, on that same page, in line 20, after “ACQUISITION;” insert “AND”; and, on that same page, strike in their entireties lines 21 and 22; and, on that same page, in line 23, strike “(VI)” and substitute “(V)”; and, on that same page, in line 24, strike “DISTRICT.” and substitute “DISTRICT, AS MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE.”; and, on that same page, in line 26, strike “(I)”; and, on that same page, in line 27, after “REPLACE” insert “EXISTING”; and, on that same page, strike in their entireties lines 28 through 30.

Amendment No. 7

On page 2, after line 30, insert:

“(F) REVENUE SOURCES.”

THE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE COMPRISED OF:

- (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND IN THE ANNUAL ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES;
- (2) GRANTS OR DONATIONS MADE TO THE FUND;
- (3) PORTIONS OF PARKING REVENUES DESIGNATED TO THE FUND BY ORDINANCE FOR APPROPRIATION IN THE ANNUAL ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES, PROVIDED THAT SUCH REVENUE IS NOT OTHERWISE PLEDGED TO PARKING FACILITY-RELATED BOND PAYMENTS OR SIMILAR OBLIGATIONS; AND
- (4) OTHER SOURCES FOR APPROPRIATION IN THE ANNUAL ORDINANCE OF ESTIMATES, AS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE.”.

Amendment No. 8

On page 3, before line 1, insert:

“(G) CONTINUING NATURE OF FUND.”

NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS CHARTER, UNSPENT PORTIONS OF THE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION, REPAYMENTS OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST ON LOANS PROVIDED FROM THE FUND, AND INTEREST EARNED FROM THE DEPOSIT OR INVESTMENT OF MONIES FROM THE FUND:

(1) SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND, TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION;

(2) DO NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL REVENUES OF THE CITY; AND

(3) ANY APPROPRIATIONS DO NOT LAPSE.”.
