Recitals

13 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$1,417,451 in excess of the revenue

relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for

15 Fiscal Year 2024.

16 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of 17 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2024 was formulated.

- 18 The source of this additional revenue is Income Tax State Collected.
- <u>This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the</u>
 <u>Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2024 was formulated or is for a new program that could</u>
 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

On February 5, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the CityCouncil.

2 \$1,417,451 shall be made available to the Board of Elections – Service 899 (Fair Conduct of

3 Elections) as a Supplementary Special Revenue General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal

4 Year 2024, to provide funding for emergency security equipment and unbudgeted mailing costs

5 from 2024 elections. The source of revenue for this appropriation is Income Tax - State

6 Collected in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates

7 in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2024.

8 **SECTION 2.** AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 9 enacted.
