The Finance Department agrees in principle with charging for use of reservoirs for recreation purposes. Currently, these resources, due to their location, provide untaxed benefits to non-city residents. At the same time the City incurs expenses to protect and maintain these resources. At this time, the Finance Department is unsure of the benefit-cost of charging for the use of the reservoirs. Once the usage data is compiled, the department will analyze the cost-benefit of applying a fee for recreational usage of the reservoirs.
