I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 08-0054.

Midtown Community Benefits District and Management Authority – Renewal through June 30, 2012.

The purpose of the bill is to renew and continue the Midtown Community Benefits District and Management Authority; provide for a special effective date; and generally relating to the activities and authority of the Midtown Community Benefits District and Management Authority.

Under conditions set forth in the enabling ordinance, the City Council is required to hold a public hearing (every four years) to evaluate the activities and undertakings of the Authority and the District, and to determine whether the District should continue for an additional four years.

The Department of Transportation supports the continuation of the Midtown Community Benefits District and the Management Authority for an additional four years (ending June 30, 2012) and therefore has no objection to the passage of City Council Bill 08-0054.
