At its regular meeting of November 19, 2009 the Planning Commission considered City Council Bill #09-0400, which is for the purpose of amending Ordinance 89-232, 93-224, and 97-127, which authorized a conditional use for an incinerator, to repeal certain geographic restrictions on the use of the incinerator; clarifying, conforming, and correcting certain citations and related language; and providing for a special effective date.

In its consideration of this Bill, the Planning Commission reviewed the attached staff report which recommended approval of City Council Bill #09-0400 and adopted the following resolution, seven (7) members being present (seven in favor).

RESOLVED, That the Planning Commission concurs with the recommendation of its departmental staff, and recommends that City Council Bill #09-0400 be passed by the City Council.
