City Council Bill #08-0184 has been introduced for the purpose of requiring certain large waste containers to be registered; defining certain terms; requiring certain information; prohibiting certain conduct; and imposing certain civil and criminal penalties.

This Bill, if passed, would add Article 23-Sanitation; Sections 5-1 to 5-18 – "Subtitle 5. "Dumpsters" and Similar Containers" to the Baltimore City Code. This section addresses the general definition of dumpsters and the subsequent requirements and regulations pertaining to their use. It also allows for the establishment of an annual fee for the registration of dumpsters and for fines. The Bill does not clearly specify a fee amount.

The Department of Finance was not able to determine the number of additional dumpsters that would be impacted by this Bill, and since a fee is not clearly established, we are not able to make a determination regarding the fiscal impact at this time. Therefore, we defer to the other agency responses regarding Council Bill 08-0184.
