2 **Historic Restorations and Rehabilitations – Tax Credit**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the automatic termination of the tax credit for certain  
4 improvements to historic properties; providing for a special effective date; and generally  
5 relating to tax credits against the Baltimore City real property tax.

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
12 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

14 **Article 28. Taxes**

15 **Subtitle 10. Credits**

16 **§ 10-8. Historic restorations and rehabilitations.**

17 (m) *Termination of program.*

18 Applications for the credit may not be accepted after [March 1, 2007] FEBRUARY 28,  
19 2009.

20 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
21 are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
22 Ordinance.
