RE: City Council Bill 10-0621-Residential Permit Parking-Area 2

The Baltimore Police Department (BPD) has reviewed City Council Bill 10-0621-Residential Permit Parking-Area 2. The bill proposes to modify the parking limitations within the Morgan Residential Parking area and generally relates to the Residential Permit Parking Program.

The BPD has only enforcement responsibilities in this area and shares these responsibilities with the Parking Authority of Baltimore City. It is recognized that there are limited parking options within certain neighborhoods and that modifying the times associated with permissive parking would allow residents additional parking within their communities.
