**For the purpose of condemning and closing McElderry Street, extending from the west side of Dean Street, Westerly 592.5 feet, more or less, to the east side of a 15-foot alley, laid out in the area of the properties known as Nos. 401 through 645 N. Highland Avenue, as shown on Plat 212-A-18A in the Office of the Department of General Services; and providing for a special effective date.**

The Department of Transportation has no objections to the passage of the bill and will not be affected by the proposed closing and selling, provided access to any utilities is maintained.
