- 1. Chairman Torrence called the hearing to order, introduced the committee members in attendance.
- 2. The floor was open to comments from Chair

- 5. The floor was open to agency reports
 - a. Presentation from administration (include in the bill file)
- 6. Questions from Members
 - a. How does Fire Marshal Staff compare (4 in city)
 - i. Often 6 or more in other jurisdictions
 - ii. Creating plan review reclassifications
 - iii. Pins are being reclassified no exact timeline for completion.
 - iv. Looking for a youth workforce but also to bring in retired workforce from other jurisdictions.
 - v. Reclassifications have been approved by finance and moved to HR then BOE by ideally by May 7.*
 - b. How many additional personnel are needed for the current workload
 - i. BCFD looking at this with the Administration
 - ii. Hoping that the 3rd party review can help with the volume conservatively 25% of workload could go there
 - c. Will there be additional funding for additional staff in budget
 - i. *Asking for follow up in 2 weeks for ideal staffing number for:
 - 1. Cause determination (investigators)
 - 2. Inspections
 - 3. Permit review
 - ii. How will these pins be added (budget mods?)
 - 1. 31 FTE in marshal
 - 2. 3 vacancies
 - 3. Reclassifying for 3
 - iii. Thus far only 4 projects have met the threshold for 3rd party review
 - 1. *Follow up requesting comms campaign to advertise that option* Bmore FAST v building code – admin committing to comprehensive comms plan to Bmore FAST follow up by budget hearings with overview and timeline
 - 2. *Follow up from administration in 2 weeks on the ability to issue 3rd party review plan*.
 - iv. How do we validate these 3rd party reviewers?
 - 1. Currently under review reviewer needs credentials fire protection engineer credential
 - d. Public Dashboard for the permit system
 - i. *Dashboard live by budget hearings
 - ii. *List of reports and metrics to be included in the dashboard in one month
 - e. *Establish integrity testing work with law & ethics to see about the establishment
 - f. Capacity to support permit czar?
 - i. Still being looked at

- g. Are we asking for budget enhancements for this?
 - i. Not at this time looking to prioritize other issues like at the Fire Dept first.
- h. Timelines for permit review looking for standardization
 - i. *Timeline of Bmore fast implementation before budget hearing*

 - i. Hoping this can be done in-house
- j. Are permit staff full-time in the office?
 - i. Yes
- k. * How much is the Bmore fast program going to cost follow up by first week of April
 consolidated cost director, pins,*
- 1. Inspections v inspectors
 - i. Qualifications v what they do
 - ii. Certification from fire academy for permit plans review (could be as much as 6 months)
- m. 3rd party inspection clarification of Bmore Fast v plan review
 - i. Bmore fast will be more building, electric, mechanic, plan review is more fire?
 - 1. Bmore fast will be a city-wide initiative will include fire permitting & review?
- n. How long for a use and occupancy permit?
 - i. 5-10 days
- o. Can we delineate between time spent waiting for the applicant (to upload plans, or resubmit updates, ect...) & time for the city to review
- p. What kind of improvements can we expect from the fire dept
 - i. Hard to say at this point (check record with Wallace & Ames)
 - ii. Use of 3rd party inspectors very mixed bag
- q. Will this add additional cost to permits
 - i. No developers to pay cost for 3rd parties
- r. Who will be eligible
 - i. Still being flushed out
- s. What are the next top 3 priorities for Bmore fast
 - i. Recruit director
 - ii. Recruit advisory board
 - iii. Legislative priorities from the admin to the council
 - 1. Several in admin report (see bill file)
- t. Do we have a sense of issues solved v. calls answered by phone line for permits
 - i. Yes and can get more info on this from BCIT
- u. *What % of calls are being resolved at call center v referred to a technician March 24-Feb 25 follow up with BCIT for a timeline*
