1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 style="text-align:center">**City Streets – Naming an Unnamed Alley Toad Lane**

3 FOR the purpose of naming an unnamed alley, located parallel to and between Normandy Place  
4 and Lombardy Place and perpendicular to a 20-foot alley, parallel with West Northern  
5 Parkway between Roland Avenue and Falls Road.

11 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the  
12 unnamed alley, located parallel to and between Normandy Place and Lombardy Place and  
13 perpendicular to a 20-foot alley, parallel with West Northern Parkway between Roland Avenue  
14 and Falls Road, is named Toad Lane.

15 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
16 after the date it is enacted.
