The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0194 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would authorize reserved parking for individuals with temporary disabilities in certain situations. The bill also clarifies existing language in Section 9 of Article 31 of the Baltimore City Code.

The bill is in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Baltimore City Code and permissibly accommodates disabled individuals to a greater degree than required by State Law. *See* COMAR 11.16.03.03. Therefore, the Law Department approves the bill for form and legal sufficiency.
