RPP Area 48 (Riverside) – Revisions

FOR the purpose of modifying the hours of applicable parking restrictions for Residential Parking Plan Area 48 (Riverside); reducing the non-permit parking time threshold; establishing an exception to the applicable permit limit; and correcting and conforming related provisions.

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That Section II of the Parking Management Restatement Plan for Residential Permit Parking Area 48 - Riverside read as follows:

**Residential Permit Parking Program  
Parking Management Plan Restatement  
RPP Area 48 - Riverside**

**II. The parking restrictions that will be posted and enforced in Area 48 are:**

**“NO PARKING / 6 PM - 7 AM / MONDAY - [SUNDAY] SATURDAY**

**[2 HOUR PARKING LIMIT / 5 PM - 11 PM, MONDAY - SATURDAY / 1 PM - 11 PM  
SUNDAY / ] NO PARKING 2 PM SUNDAY - 7 AM MONDAY**


