12 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
13 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

15 **Article 14. Special Benefits Districts**

16 **Subtitle 6. Charles Village Community Benefits District**

17 **§ 6-6. Board of Directors.**

18 (e) *Minimum representation.*

19 The following minimum representation shall be present on the full Board, except during  
20 periods of temporary vacancies:

22 (2) 2 VOTING members shall be members of the City Council appointed by the  
23 President of the City Council.

**Council Bill 12-0037**

1       **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
