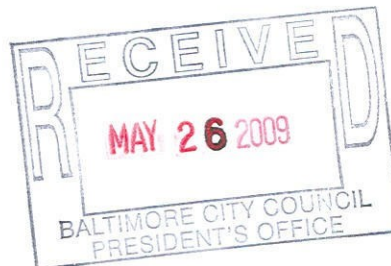


I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 09-0329 introduced by Council President Stephanie Rawlings-Blake at the request of Baltimore Development Corporation.

The purpose of this Bill is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan for Carroll Camden to revise an exhibit to reflect land use changes in the Plan; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority has reviewed Council Bill 09-0329 and determined there would be no impact to any administered parking program for on-street parking activity and/or City owned off-street parking facilities. The Parking Authority will continue to be involved in the review of development projects in the Carroll Camden area to ensure that parking needs are met as part of those developments.

Based on the comments above, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 09-0329.
