3 4 5 6	FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$47,492,889 to the Police Department – Service 622 (Police Patrol), to provide funding to balance the Police Department's Fiscal Year 2025 budget for a deficit caused by overtime and staffing costs; and providing for a special effective date.
7 8 9 10 11	By authority of Article VI - Board of Estimates Section 8(b)(2)(iii) and (c) Baltimore City Charter (1996 Edition)
12	Recitals
13 14 15	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$47,492,889 in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.
16 17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.
18 19 20	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated or is for a new program that could not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
21 22	On October 15, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

l	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$47,492,889 shall be made available to the Police Department – Service 622 (Police Patrol) as a
3	Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2025, to provide funding
1	to balance the Police Department's Fiscal Year 2025 budget for a deficit caused by overtime and
5	staffing costs. The source of revenue for this appropriation is General Fund assigned Fund
5	Balance in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in
7	determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
