Ladies and Gentlemen:

City Council Bill #08-0111 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals for study and report.

The purpose of this legislation is to approve certain amendments to the Development Plan of the Marketplace at Fells Point Planned Unit Development.

The Marketplace at Fells Point is currently comprised of thirty properties. Three of these properties are owned by the City. The total PUD size is 4.405 acres. Now the development team has identified two additional privately owned properties and with the addition of two more City-owned properties proposes to expand the boundaries of the PUD to include these four extra properties. The properties are 616 South Regester Street, 620 South Broadway, 1630 Aliceanna Street and 920-950 South Broadway. The properties within the PUD area are zoned B-2-2 or R-8.

The Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals has reviewed this legislation and the Planning Department staff report and concurs that and City Council Bill #08-0111 should be passed.
