Dear Madame President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0024R for form and legal sufficiency. This resolution would create a task force to study the potential for an overhaul of the City's current noise laws and the feasibility of creating a more defined, easily enforced, and encompassing noise law for the City.

In general, a City Council resolution is "an expression of opinion or mind concerning some particular item of business coming within the legislative body's official cognizance." Inlet Assocs. v. Assateague House Condominium Assoc., 545 A.2d 1296, 1303 (Md. 1988) (quoting McQuillin Mun. Corp. § 15:2 (3rd Ed.)). Council Bill 08-0024R is an appropriate resolution to express the Council's decision to create a task force concerning noise laws and enforcement in the City.
