Re: City Council Bill 15-0573 - Rezoning - 502 Albemarle Street and a

**Portion of Duker Alley** 

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 15-0573, for the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 502 Albemarle Street from the B-3-2 Zoning District and the M-2-2 Zoning District to the B-2-4 Zoning District, and by changing the zoning for a portion of the property known as Duker Alley from the M-2-2 Zoning District to the B-2-4 Zoning District.

If enacted, this bill would allow rezoning from the M-2-2 and B-3-2 to the B-2-4 zoning for a .074 acre site on Albemarle Street. The property is adjacent to a proposed site for high rise mixed-use development on 801-809 Eastern Avenue. The new zoning would make the property more consistent with the neighborhood and the proposed new mixed-use development site.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the passage of City Council Bill 15-0573.
