The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 21-0072 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill is for the purpose of revising the local 911 telephone fee; and providing for a special effective date.

The bill is authorized by Section 1-311 of the Public Safety Article of the Maryland Code. Md. Code, Pub. Safety § 1-311 (c)(2) (fee may be increased to no more than \$1.50 for the next fiscal year if revenues do not cover operational costs of the system).

Therefore, the Law Department can approve City Council Bill 21-0072 for form and legal sufficiency.
