BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in 11 accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either 12 public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property 13 known as 1600 Guilford Avenue (Block 0429, Lot 023), and more particularly described as 14 follows: 15 The subject parcel (Block 0429, Lot 023) is an unimproved lot, containing 1.712 16 acres, more or less. 17 This property being no longer needed for public use. 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance 19 unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor. 20 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED. That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it 21 is enacted. 22
