12 13	<b>SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE</b> , That the City Charter is proposed to be amended to read as follows:

17	(a) Members; DESIGNEES; Salary.
18	(1) The Board shall consist of [five] 7 members:
19	(I) the [Mayor,] MAYOR;

21	(III) THE PRESIDENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL;

8 9	The Board shall designate a clerk to the Board who shall keep its accounts and a record of its proceedings.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> , That this proposed amendment to the City Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form specified by the City Solicitor.
