## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

3	FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation in the	
4	amount of \$90,000 to the Department of Recreation and Parks – Service 654 (Urban	
5	Forestry), to provide funding for addressing the pressing concerns surrounding the	
6	detrimental impact of deer on the forested natural areas within Baltimore City parks,	
7	particularly those affecting forest ecology in U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA")	
8	Inflation Reduction Act ("IRA") Disadvantaged Communities; and providing for a special	
9	effective date.

16	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents State funding a grant from the State of	
17	Maryland Department of Natural Resources Community Catalyst Fund in excess of the revenue	
18	relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for	
19	Fiscal Year 2025.	
20	That funding grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the	
21	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.	
22	On February 7, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City	
23	Council.

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$90,000 shall be made available to the Department of Recreation and Parks – Service 654 (Urban
3	Forestry) as a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2025, to
4	provide funding for addressing the pressing concerns surrounding the detrimental impact of deer
5	on the forested natural areas within Baltimore City parks, particularly those affecting forest
6	ecology in EPA IRA Disadvantaged Communities. The source of revenue for this appropriation
7	is the State funding a grant from the State of Maryland Department of Natural Resources
8	Community Catalyst Fund in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the
9	Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year
10	2025.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
