The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 21-0105 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill alters the applicable block faces included in Residential Parking Plan Area 26 (Campbell Lane); and altering the hours of applicable parking restrictions to be consistent with a prior Parking Authority of Baltimore City administrative order.

The Law Department notes that page 1, line 8 of the bill errs by stating the bill is authorized by City Code Article 31, §10-19(a). In fact, City Code Article 31, §10-19(a) permits an ordinance to modify a parking management plan, as provided by this bill. For this reason, the Law Department offers the attached amendment.

Provided the bill is amended as suggested, the Law Department is prepared to approve the bill.
