3	FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and
4	operation of a banquet hall on the property known as 2103-2105 West North Avenue, as
5	outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
12	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a banquet hall on the
13	property known as 2103-2105 West North Avenue, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying
14	this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-309(9) and 14-102, subject
15	to the condition that the following conditions:
16	1. Meeting and banquet hall use is limited to 2103-2105 West North Avenue.
17	2. The sale of tickets to the general public for live entertainment and dancing events in
18	the meeting and banquet hall is prohibited.
19	3. The uses permitted in the hall shall include events that are catered for:
20	(a) life cycle events (such as Christenings, Confirmations, Bar/Bat Mitzvahs,
21	engagement parties, showers, weddings, birthdays, wakes, family
22	celebrations);

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
