**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Baltimore City Landmark List – The Mount**

FOR the purpose of designating The Mount, 3706 Nortonia Road, as a historical landmark.

By adding

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation  
Section(s) 12-17  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation**

**Subtitle 12. Landmark List - 2000s**

**§ 12-17. THE MOUNT.**

THE MOUNT, 3706 NORTONIA ROAD.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance  
are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior  
Ordinance.

**SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
after the date it is enacted.
