13	Metropolitan District of Baltimore County to a tract of land, consisting of approximately 13.793
14	acres, located in the 4C4 Election District of Baltimore County in the vicinity of the south side of
15	Nicodemus Road and the northeast side of I-795, 500 feet east of Cherry Hill Lane, as more
16	particularly shown on the plat labeled Extension 151 and filed with the Department of Public
17	Works of Baltimore County.
18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
19	is enacted.
