You have asked the Law Department to review City Council Bill 09-0305 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would change the name of Bentalou Elementary School #150, located at 220 North Bentalou Street, to Mary Ann Winterling Elementary School #150.

The bill is consistent with Article 5, Subtitle 20 of the Baltimore City Code, which provides that “City property shall be named or renamed by an ordinance of the Mayor and City Council.”

Accordingly, the Law Department approves Council Bill 09-0305 for form and legal sufficiency.
