A RESOLUTION ENTITLED

1 A COUNCIL RESOLUTION concerning

2 **Approval for the Exchange of a Class B-D-7 License to a**  
3 **Class A-7 License – 1503-05 Light Street**

4 FOR the purpose of providing the required approval under Md. Code Ann., Alc. Bev.  
5 § 12-902.1(c)(1) to allow the license holder holding a valid Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and  
6 Liquor License issued for 1503-05 Light Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21230 to apply to the  
7 Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City to exchange their Class B-D-7  
8 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License for a Class A-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License.

9 **Recitals**

10 Under Md. Code Ann., Alc. Bev. § 12-902.1(c)(1), a City Council resolution is required to  
11 allow a current holder of a valid Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License issued on or before  
12 July 1, 2018 to apply to the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City to  
13 exchange their Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License for a Class A-7 Beer, Wine, and  
14 Liquor License.

15 The Class A-7 License authorizes the license holder to sell Beer, Wine, and Liquor at retail at  
16 the place described in the license for off-premise consumption. The holder of a Class A-7  
17 License may sell Beer, Wine, and Liquor on Monday through Sunday from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00  
18 p.m.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the City  
20 Council authorizes, by and through this resolution, that the current holder of a Class B-D-7 Beer,  
21 Wine, and Liquor License located at 1503-05 Light Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21230, may  
22 apply to the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City (the “Board”) to  
23 exchange its Class B-D-7 Beer, Wine, and Liquor License for a Class A-7 Beer, Wine, and  
24 Liquor License and may be afforded all the privileges and responsibilities of that license class  
25 and type under the Alcoholic Beverages Article for the State of Maryland.

26 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Executive  
27 Secretary of the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City.
