The City Administrators Office (CAO) is herein reporting on City Council Bill 22-0098R Upkeep and Maintenance of Vacant Lots and Public Green Spaces.

Council Bill 22-0098R requests the presence of the Director of the Department of Recreation and Parks, the Director of the Department of Planning, Director of the Department of Transportation, the Director of the Department of Housing and Community Development, the Head of the Bureau of Solid Waste, the Sustainability Coordinator, a representative from the Office of the Comptroller, the Chief of the Bureau of Budget and Management Research, and the City Administrator to provide and discuss the annual cumulative total of calls for service regarding the upkeep and maintenance of vacant lots and green spaces.

Conclusions:

The Office of the City Administrator welcomes discussion and questions regarding tracking of City services and diligently supports the work of CleanStat wherein a number of the referred agencies collaborate to strategize successful delivery of services to residents and report on their respective maintenance of City properties.
