15	§ 2-103. City modifications.
16 17	The additional, deletions, amendments, and other modifications adopted by the City are as follows:
18 19	Section 109.5.3 Permit extensions. For a permit extension issued under this Code, the charge is as follows:
20 21	1. If the application for extension is made within [90] 30 days after the permit expires, the fee for the extension is \$25.

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	2.	If the application for extension is made between 31-90 days after the permit expires,
2		the fee for the extension is 50% of the original permit fee. Alternatively, the applicant
3		may apply for a new permit for the work remaining to be completed, with the fee for
k		that permit to be based on the scope of that remaining work.
