

At its regular meeting of August 9, 2016, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation considered City Council Bill 16-0698: Baltimore City Landmark List: Exteriors– George W. King/Abraham Briscoe House.

In its consideration of this Bill, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation reviewed the attached staff report which recommended a finding of Approval for designation of this property on the Baltimore City Landmark List because it meets criteria 1 and 2 of CHAP's criteria for designation (10 members being present, 10 in favor).

After the hearing, CHAP staff met with the owners of the property and supported changing the name to George W. King/Abraham Briscoe/Bethel Community House.
