15	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$1,900,000 in excess of the revenue
16	relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for
17	Fiscal Year 2023.
18	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
19	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated.
20	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
21	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2023 was formulated or is for a new program that could
22	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
23	On November 15, 2023, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
24	Council.

Council Bill 23-0461

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$1,900,000 shall be made available to the Department of Law – Service 860 (Administration-
Law) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2023, to
provide funding for balancing the Department of Law budget for Fiscal Year 2023 due legal fees
and support services fees exceeding the adopted budget. The source of revenue for this
appropriation is generated from investment earnings in excess of the amount from this source
that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the
budget for Fiscal Year 2023.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
