**INTRODUCTION** – City Property - Renaming Eastwood Field to Mayes Meadow

**PURPOSE/PLANS** – For the purpose of changing the name of Eastwood Field, located on the northeast side of Herring Run within Herring Run Park, adjacent to 3602 Eastwood Drive, to Mayes Meadow.

**COMMENTS** – Council Bill 21-0046 seeks to rename Eastwood Field, located within Northeast Baltimore’s Herring Run Park, to Mayes Meadow. The renaming is being sought to honor longtime park volunteers Bob and Betty Mayes.
