The Mayor's Office on Criminal Justice (MOCJ) has reviewed City Council Bill No.12-0202 – Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation and supports the requested appropriation.

City Council Bill No. 12-0202 seeks to authorize the use of grant funds in the amount of \$938,773.00 which has been awarded to the Mayor's Office on Criminal Justice on September 25, 2012 (FY2012) by the United States Department of Justice's Bureau of Justice Assistance. The project period of this grant shall run from October 01, 2012 – September 30, 2015.

Acceptance of this grant was acknowledged and approved by the Mayor's Office on Criminal Justice on October 19, 2012. All funds are to be utilized for the McElderry Park Revitalization Coalition, which is a group a community resident and stakeholders who will identify the drivers of crime and risk-factors within their community and assign appropriate evidence-based programs to address said risk-factors.
