Legislative Oversight – Underground Fire Safety

Purpose:

For the purpose of inviting relevant city agencies & utility providers to discuss recent safety issues in Baltimore's underground electrical system

BACKGROUND

Media reports indicate that there have been 10 underground fire incidents in Baltimore since 2014.¹ Since January of 2024, there have been 3 underground fires (January, June, & September of 2024) on North Charles Street. These fires have done property damage, cut utilities & telecommunications for thousands of Baltimore residents, and disrupted some City government operations such as the central library, sheriff's office, and courts being closed.²

According to one media report – members of the Baltimore City Fire Department have noted that these fires are especially difficult to address because of the difficulty in reaching the fire and the added challenge of the electricity running in the underground tunnel. The power must be turned off before the fire can be addressed. 3

In the September fire one firefighter was taken to the hospital for minor injury.⁴
