

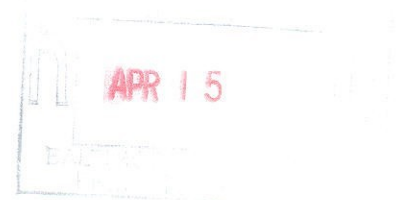


I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 11-0652 introduced by Council President Bernard "Jack" Young at the request of The Administration (Department of Housing and Community Development).

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. has reviewed the amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Middle East to reauthorize the acquisition of properties within the Project Area to correct and clarify certain language; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

It has been determined there would be no negative impact to parking in the Middle East area as a direct result of this amendment. The Parking Authority would be readily available to other City Agencies, work-groups, and/or developers to assist with any on-street parking activity associated with this amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 11-0652.



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
