The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 08-0115 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill makes technical corrections to the Baltimore City Code. The bill also repeals certain obsolete provisions. The bill makes one substantive change to the existing Code, which adds the Commission on Sustainability to the list of agencies required to file a financial disclosure in section 7-8 of the Ethics Article of the City Code. Both the technical and the substantive changes made by the bill are consistent with the City Code.

Accordingly, the Law Department approves City Council Bill 08-0115 for form and legal sufficiency.
