Re: **City Council Bill 11-0774 - Baltimore City Landmark List - St. Peter the Apostle Church Complex**

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0774, which was introduced for the purpose of designating St. Peter the Apostle Church Complex, 13 South Poppleton Street, 11 South Poppleton Street, 848 Hollins Street, and 16 Shout Poppleton Street, as a historical landmark.

This bill would designate the St. Peter the Apostle Church Complex, located at 13 South Poppleton Street, 11 South Poppleton Street, 848 Hollins Street, and 16 Shout Poppleton Street, as a Baltimore City Landmark. The Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation (CHAP) has indicated that the building meets the City's Landmark designation criteria.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the adoption of City Council Bill 11-0774.
