City Council Bill 11-0723 - City Streets - Closing - Certain Alleys Bounded by Riverside

Road, Levin Road, and Meadow Road

The Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0723, which was introduced for the purpose of condemning and closing certain alleys bounded by Riverside Road, Levin Road, and Meadow Road, as shown on Plat 347-A-74A in the Office of the Department of General Services; and providing for a special effective date.

The above-noted bill, along with its companion, City Council Bill 11-0722, both relate to the condemning, closing and sale of certain alley beds needed to consolidate the property in question so that Riverside Properties, LLC-a light manufacturing business located at 121 Riverside Road-can expand and double its business. Riverside Properties, LLC owns all of the adjacent properties, save one, and the owner of that property has signed a letter consenting to the requested closure of the portions of unimproved alleys.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has no objection to the adoption of City Council Bill 11-0723.
