- WHEREAS, Fees charged by the City should reflect the cost of providing the service for which the fee is charged.
- WHEREAS, Using standardized, cost accounting methods, the City has performed a cost analysis of the fees charged by the Planning Department.
- SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the fees charged by the Planning Department are changed to reflect the actual cost of the service rendered, as follows:
