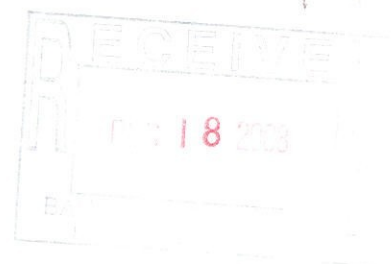
Dear Madame President and City Council Members:
