3 FOR the purpose of inviting representatives from the Department of Housing and Community
4 Development, the Department of Planning, the Department of Transportation, the Office of
5 the Comptroller, the Department of Real Estate, the Department of Recreation and Parks, the
6 Department of Public Works, the Department of General Services, and other interested
7 parties to discuss the current condition of City-owned lots and buildings, how maintenance of
8 such properties can be improved, and the impact poorly-maintained City-owned lots and
9 buildings have on Baltimore City as a whole.

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the City
11 Council invites representatives from the Department of Housing and Community Development,
12 the Department of Planning, the Department of Transportation, the Office of the Comptroller, the
13 Department of Real Estate, the Department of Recreation and Parks, the Department of Public
14 Works, the Department of General Services, and other interested parties to discuss the current
15 condition of City-owned lots and buildings, how maintenance of such properties can be
16 improved, and the impact poorly-maintained City-owned lots and buildings have on Baltimore
17 City as a whole.

18 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Commissioner
19 of the Department of Housing and Community Development, the Director of the Department of
20 Planning, the Director of the Department of Transportation, the Baltimore City Comptroller, the
21 Director of the Department of Recreation and Parks, and the Mayor's Legislative Liaison to the
22 City Council.
