FOR the purpose of increasing the criminal and prepayable citation penalties for certain littering offenses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

§ 7-706. Penalties: [\$200] \$500.
