4 5 6	For the purpose of approving the submission of an application to the State of Maryland for the expansion of Baltimore City's Consolidated Enterprise Zone and creation of one new Focus Area.
7 8 9 10	WHEREAS, The City Council recognizes that there is a significant need to stimulate the creation of jobs by establishing an Enterprise Zone in Jones Falls/Reservoir Hill and creating a Focus Area in the Fairfield and Hawkins Point Industrial Area (See the attached map for a complete listing of all areas affected by the approval of this Resolution.); and
11 12	WHEREAS, The City of Baltimore and representatives of the Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) have been working towards this end; and
13 14 15	WHEREAS, The General Assembly of the State of Maryland established an Enterprise Zone Program to focus State and local resources on the encouragement of economic growth in economically distressed areas and employment opportunities for the unemployed; and
16 17 18	<b>WHEREAS</b> , The City of Baltimore, through the Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC), has prepared an application for the expansion of the Enterprise Zone to include these aforementioned areas; and
19 20	WHEREAS, The regulations of the Enterprise Zone Program require the written expression of the sentiment of the Baltimore City Council.
21 22	Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the City Council of Baltimore:
23 24	1. Hereby endorses this April 2011 application of the City for the expansion of the existing Enterprise Zone and the creation of the new Focus Area within the Zone.
