20	(2) DO NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL REVENUES OF THE CITY; AND
21	(3) THEIR APPROPRIATIONS DO NOT LAPSE.

23	Charter be submitted to the legal and qualified voters of Baltimore City, for adoption or
24	rejection, in accordance with Article XI-A, § 5 of the Maryland Constitution, in the form
25	specified by the City Solicitor.
